Working closely with all **NHS** and **Social Care** partners across Norfolk and Waveney, **Next Gen Health and Care** will be able to provide entry routes for 16-30 year olds looking to start employment.

To access this opportunity you must be **aged 16-30 and not be in education, employment or training** (or less than 16hrs/week).

Opportunities include: Clinical / Care, Apprenticeship, Estates / Facilities, Admin, Pharmacy, and many more.

HOW IT WORKS



01

Once an individual signs up, they will be introduced to the Next Gen project and supported to complete an initial assessment questionnaire - this will form the foundation of an employment plan.



02

Following this, they will be provided with 1-to-1 support in order to create a bespoke pathway into Health and Social Care employment, and to assist them with applying for jobs and preparing for interviews.

During their time with us, they will also be invited to join online sessions to meet employers, learn about values, and to provide them with guidance and support when making an application.
